1. Call 911 at once if anyone is injured.
2. Date, time and location of the collision: _____
3. Take photos of damage to the vehicles if safe to do so.

5. Be sure police are called if there is serious collision damage, or if anyone was hurt. Make out a police report at the scene.
6. Get a business card from the police officer at the scene, with the police report number on it:

8. Report to the accident to your automobile insurance company immediately.
9. Be sure that any witnesses speak to the police.
10. Don't admit you were at fault – you may be confused or mistaken!
11. Do not confront or threaten the other driver. This can lead to dangerous situations.
12. Seek medical attention immediately—many injuries do not seem serious at first.
13. Do not give a statement to the other driver's insurance company until you have consulted a lawyer.
